FISHING WITH US? WHAT TO EXPECT. If you are driving to Bay Flats Lodge, plan to arrive between 3-4 P.M. for check-in. Our staff will then move you into your room, give a tour of the facilities, and appetizers will be served out at the outdoor kitchen. Dinner will be served between 6:00 and 6:30 P.M. After dinner, you're welcome to relax in the rocking chairs on the deck, sit around the fire ring, play cards, washers, horse shoes, or tell stories in the outdoor kitchen.

A hot breakfast will be served along with a continental breakfast between 5:00 and 6:30 A.M. After breakfast you will be met by two 6-passenger golf carts at the bottom stairs of the great room, and driven to our private docks at the end of our driveway where you will meet your guide for a daybreak departure. Lunch will be served on the boat and will consist of croissant sandwiches with plenty of meats and cheeses, Miss Vick's chips, chocolate chip and white macadamia nut cookies, with plenty of cold bottled water and soft drinks. The fishing day usually last 8 hours, after which you will be brought back to the lodge to shower and relax before your drive home, or stay over another evening at the lodge.

FISHING QUICKLIST

BASIC ITEMS :Regardless of the type of fishing being done while at the Lodge, all anglers will need to bring the following things with them on their fishing trip:

- Texas Saltwater Fishing License with Saltwater Stamp
- Suitable Clothing
- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- Hat
- Ice Chest (to take your catch home in)

IF FISHING FROM THE BOAT: If you, and your party, are to be fishing from the boat during your day of fishing, we will provide boat-fishing anglers with rods, reels, tackle, and ice.

Live Bait is Extra (an expense added to your invoice at the end of your stay at the Lodge)

WADE-FISHING: If you, and your party, wish to wade-fish during your day on the water, we will provide the lures, but please inform all members of your wading party that they will need to bring their own following gear:

- Rod
- Reel
- Landing Net (if preferred)
- Stringer (if preferred)
- Live Bait Bucket (if fishing with live bait)
- Chest Waders (when applicable)
- Wading Boots
- Stingray Guards
- Wading Belt

- Mosquito Spray
- Camouflage Face Net/Mask
- Rain Gear / Parka / Jacket
- Gun Cleaning Kit
- Camouflage Clothing (brown/green)
- Camera
- Ice Chest
- Texas Hunting License / Voucher - Call 1-800-TX-LIC-4U
- Federal Waterfowl Stamp

From Houston (approximately 150 miles)

Take Highway 59 to Ganado

Exit Highway 59 at Highway 172

Take Highway 172 South to Highway 35



Turn RIGHT and take Highway 35 through Port Lavaca to Highway 185

Turn LEFT and take Highway 185 to Seadrift



Continue on 185 through Seadrift approximately 1.0 mile to Dierlam Road (Across from RUDON on 185) turn RIGHT onto Dierlam

(The next turn is coming up quick on your left)

Travel 0.25 miles to Old Settlement Road, Turn LEFT and travel 1.25 miles to Swan Point Road



Turn RIGHT on Swan Point Road and travel 0.6 Miles to SWAN POINT LANDING ENTRANCE

GATE CODE is 2686#. Go straight thru gate all way down.

Turn RIGHT at Bayside Drive and travel 0.6 Miles

to BAY FLATS LODGE, directly across from Swan Point Marina.
